## Ice Rink

Freeport has an ice rink! It is open to the public. It is well-lit from sundown to 10pm. It is located next to the interstate softball park (the one near the community center).

## All Parking Rules

Reminder that you should not have vehicles and recreational vehicles (campers, boats, trailers, etc.) parked on the street for longer than two days.

## Winter Parking Rules

Now that winter has arrived we thought it would be a good idea to remind everyone of the winter parking rules. Winter parking rules are enforced from November 1<sup>st</sup> – March 31<sup>st</sup>. There can be no parking on public streets or municipal parking lots between 2:30am-6am during or after any snowfall that accumulates over 1/10 of an inch.

Also, residents and businesses are responsible for clearing the sidewalks in front of their properties.

## Expired Tabs

Reminder that it is against city ordinance to have vehicles without current tabs and that look inoperable (i.e. flat/missing tires, missing part, etc.)

## Grease/Oil

We are still experiencing a lot of grease in our sanitary sewer line. This is extremely problematic and we need residents to refrain from dumping grease down drains. Again, doing this could result in resident's personal lines getting blocked and causing backups, along with City sewer lines.
