FREEPORT CITY COUNCIL REGULAR MEETING MINUTES February 19, 2013

A regular meeting of the Freeport City Council was convened at 7:00 P.M. by Mayor Matt Worms with Council Members Rodney Atkinson, Ron Ritter, Carrie Goebel and Ken Goebel also in attendance.

Also in attendance: Carol Moorman, Rick Scherping, June Scherping, Gary Meyer, Jerome Klaphake, Arnold Blommel (Krain Twsp), Steve Notch (Millwood Twsp), Mike Rosner (Oak Twsp), Bob Timp (Oak Twsp), John Arnzen (St. Rosa), Adolph Wensmann (Millwood Twsp), Robert Cremers (St. Anthony), James Cremers (St. Anthony) and Carl Toenyon (Millwood Twsp).

Staff person in attendance: Dean Jungles, John Gilk, Noah Van Beck, Jon Stueve, and Ashley Feldewerd.

The Pledge of Allegiance was said by those in attendance.

OPEN PUBLIC FORUM

No public comment was provided.

CONSENT AGENDA

Atkinson questioned whether the minutes were changed from January 10, 2013. Feldewerd stated that she would check on it to be sure that the minutes were changed. C. Goebel moved and Ritter seconded a motion approving the Consent Agenda which included the following: Approval of the agenda; approval of the minutes from the January 29, 2013 Regular Council Meeting; approval of the claims distributed January 23, 2013 through February 11, 2013, and approval of gambling license for Land of Lakes Bow Fishing Association for April 20, 2013. Motion carried 5-0.

OLD BUSINESS

Resolution 2013-013 Minor Subdivision Request: 403/407 Main St E

Jerome Klaphake commented that he would like to see the minor subdivision request approved at this meeting. Worms informed council that Feldewerd had received an email from Cynthia Smith-Strack recommending that we approve Resolution 2013-013. She stated that Sacred Heart Church had met all of the requirements that were necessary and everything was in order. C. Goebel moved and Atkinson seconded a motion to approve Resolution 2013-003. Motion carried 5-0.

Other

Gary Meyer questioned whether or not the city was going to plow the road behind the church. Stueve commented that it was just missed the last time and that they will take care of it. Atkinson made comments about city cell phones. He stated that there are cheaper routes to go in the future for cell phones.

NEW BUSINESS

Redevelopment Grant Application Update-Memo Heidi Peper

Worms gave a summary of the EDA meeting with Peper. He stated that we were denied the grant the first time around because there was only bond money available and that it has to be used for publicly owned property. He said Peper was going to look into some other grants. Feldewerd stated that Peper would be working at no cost to the city until funds are obtained. Worms stated we are looking into a 99 year lease with the developer to try to obtain funds. In the meantime she will look at other options as well.

Resolution 2013-011-2013 Stearns County All Hazard Mitigation Plan

Worms stated that we have approved this in the past and it is the same as the prior year. Feldewerd stated that if we don't accept our part of Stearns County's plan that if a natural disaster happened that we would not be eligible for funds. Atkinson requested a copy of the entire All Hazard Mitigation Plan. K. Goebel moved and C. Goebel seconded a motion to approve Resolution 2013-011. Motion carried 5-0.

Resolution 2013-012 Updated Single Audit Engagement Letter-Abdo, Eick & Meyer

Questions were asked about when we are switching to the accrual method of accounting. Feldewerd stated that the financial statements for 2012 would be prepared on the accrual basis and that USDA will cover the cost. C. Goebel moved and Ritter seconded a motion to approve Resolution 2012-012. Motion carried 5-0.

Other

Worms commented that he had received an email from Kathleen Murphy saying that she has received 17 applications and out of those she thought that two of them where worthy of interviewing. K. Goebel questioned where the position was being advertised. Worms stated that it was advertised in the St. Cloud Times, Career Builder, The Peach, The Beacon, The Sauk Centre Herald, Echo Press and with the League of Minnesota Cities.

REPORTS

Public Works Report, Jon Stueve

Worms commented that Stueve and Hoelscher were doing a great job snow plowing. Discussion was had about ideas on how to keep snowmobiles off of the sidewalks. Worms had put up signs the previous weekend as a result of resident complaints. Atkinson suggested that we talked to the snowmobile clubs. Stueve suggested getting signs that say no snowmobiles at the beginning of the season.

City Clerk/Treasurer's Report, Ashley Feldewerd

Feldewerd commented that she has heard from residents in town that public works was doing a great job and that the signs Worms put up for the snowmobilers were working and appreciated.

At 7:36 P.M. the Council took a short recess before reconvening with 2013 Annual Area Fire Service Meeting.

ANNUAL AREA FIRE SERVICE MEETING

The annual meeting of the Freeport Area Fire Service was convened at 8:01 P.M. by Mayor Matt Worms with members from Millwood Township, Oak Township, City of St. Rosa, Krain Township and the City of St. Anthony present. Albany Township was absent.

Mayor Worms welcomed the area town and city representatives to the annual meeting.

Noah Van Beck, Jon Gilk, and Dean Jungles were also present and provided a report on the calls during 2012. Members discussed the 2014 operating budget and the vehicle fund. Training requirements and schedules were also discussed. Members had questions about the safety of our firefighters. Van Beck commented that they weren't concerned as most of the calls that they respond to someone knows the resident and that interstate calls were probably the most risky.

Supervisor Timp, Oak Township moved and Supervisor Blommel, Krain Township seconded a motion to approve the 2014 budget as presented. Motion carried 6-0.

At 8:52 P.M. Atkinson moved and K. Goebel seconded a motion to adjourn the regular meeting. Motion carried 5-0.

The tower has been up and running throughout the winter. Jon and I will work on finalizing a punch list in the next few weeks. Items on the punch list include:

CSAH 11 Project
