IMPORTANT REMINDERS

City Wide Leaf Pick-Up Day

Waste Management will be picking up your bagged leaves & yard waste on Sat. Oct. 26th, 2019
Please have leaves and yard waste in an unenclosed bag by the street before 8 am.

Tree & Shrub Trimming

Please take the time to make sure your trees and shrubs are not covering the city sidewalks, streets & signs. You are responsible for the trimming of all your branches so that you are not blocking the view of street signs, and that your sidewalks are kept clear so a pedestrian can walk without obstruction. Be sure that your tree branches do not hang into the streets, as this causes issues for the street sweeping machine and larger vehicles to maneuver in the city streets.

Pet Owners

Pets are required by the City Code to be registered with the city & to be kept within the boundaries of their owner's property or otherwise leashed. Owners must pick up and dispose of animal waste from yards, city parks and streets. Not following these rules could result in nuisance violations. Also, reports of a dog running at large; barking dogs that are disturbing the peace; or a dangerous dog, may result in impound fees.

Grease & Oil

Please do not dump kitchen grease and oil down the drains. We have been having issues with residents' personal lines becoming blocked and causing backups, costing you plumbing fees. This also causes issues within the city sewer lines.

Business & Residential Garbage

We have had some complaints about Waste Management and how they been handling our garbage accounts. If you have issues that have not been resolved, please take a recent copy of your invoice and drop it off at city hall. We are currently trying to set up a time for a representative of Waste Management to come and discuss the concerns we have with their billing procedures for commercial and residential accounts.
