RESOLUTION 2022-05

A RESOLUTION REESTABLISHING PRECINCT AND POLLING PLACE

WHEREAS, the legislature of the State of Minnesota has been redistricted;

WHEREAS, Minnesota Statute section 204B.14, subd. 3 (d) requires that precinct boundaries must be reestablished within 60 days of when the legislature has been redistricted or at least 19 weeks before the state primary election, whichever comes first;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Freeport, County of Stearns, State of Minnesota hereby establishes the boundaries of the voting precincts and the polling places as follows:

Precinct 0095 Freeport City Hall, 125 Main Street East, Freeport, Minnesota

Attached to this resolution, for illustrative purposes, is a map showing said precinct and the location of the polling place.
