Grant opportunities

The IIJA money is finally trickling down to smaller communities through grant opportunities offered by the State of Minnesota. Grant opportunities that I am actively tracking for Freeport include:

Local Road Improvement program – Due in early December, this is our primary means of funding industrial drive and 7th Street.

Active Transportation Grant – We have applied before for this program and I would encourage us to apply again. Last time only 3 outstate applications were selected out of more than 80 received, but the program does fit our County Road 11 sidewalk nicely.

Mn Highway Freight Program – Historically this program has been limited to trunk highways, but this year was opened up to local roads as well. The program is focused on the "first and last" mile of the freight generation route. If that doesn't describe Industrial Drive and 7th St I don't know what does! Applications are due in Mid October. The critical feature is being able to identify the segments as a "Critical Urban Freight Corridor or a Critical Rural Freight Corridor" I am hopeful that efforts put into this grant can be re-used in the LRIP application. I have been in contact with Jodi Teich regarding the county serving as the sponsoring agency.



Cities across Minnesota will be receiving a one-time public safety aid disbursement on December 26, 2023. Freeport will be receiving \$29,844.00.

Here is an excerpt on the usage of the funds from LMC's website:

Eligible and ineligible uses of the aid

The authorizing language in the law provides categories of eligible spending, but the list is not exhaustive. It is also important to note that while legislators expected most of these funds to be used for police and fire expenses, it was intentionally written in a broad way that would allow for other uses as well. The allowable uses named in the new law include:

- Community violence prevention.
- Community intervention programs.
- Community engagement.
- Mental health crisis responses.
- Victim services.
- Training programs.
- First responder wellness.
- Equipment related to fire, rescue, and emergency services.
- Other personnel or equipment costs.

The law also specifically calls out certain uses that are not eligible. Ineligible uses include:

- Employer contribution to the Public Employees Retirement Association Police and Fire Plan if the local unit received police state aid in 2022.
- Any costs associated with alleged wrongdoing or misconduct.
- Purchase of an armored or tactical vehicle or substantially similar vehicle.
- Purchase of tear gas, chemical munitions, or substantially similar items.
- Costs of construction, reconstruction, remodeling, expansion, or improvement of a police station, including related facilities. "Related facilities" includes access roads, lighting, sidewalks, and utility components on or adjacent to the property on which the police station is located that are necessary for access to and use of the building.

Chief Andy Grieve has requested to use \$15,000 to purchase new extrication equipment. I would like to explore establishing a Freeport city app or some sort of notification system for our residents. Prepare to discuss the usage of these funds at the meeting.
